5 additional bags of yard debris allowed (each less than 40 lbs.) and/or branches cut down to less than 4 feet, bundled and tied. Items must be able to be easily carried, handled and tossed.

Acceptable items: Couches, loveseats, recliners, mattresses, box springs (all sizes), bed frames, tables, chairs, BBQ grills, empty lawnmowers

Unacceptable items:

- no electric corded items, washers, dryers, ranges, microwaves
- No electronic waste such as computers, printers or monitors
- No hazardous waste, constructions debris, car parts, hot tubs, basketball hoops, dirt, rock concrete, water heaters




Potable Pipeline Replacement Program – Irish Pat Murphy Drive

The Pinery Water District implemented a pipeline replacement program in recent years to proactively replace aging waterlines that have been the cause of untimely and expensive repairs. The goal of the program is to replace these problematic waterlines within the District to provide a more reliable system for our residents into the future. The waterline within Irish Pat Murphy Drive was constructed in the early 1970's and has experienced a relatively high number of line breaks in recent years.

The project scope includes approximately one mile of new waterline within Irish Pat Murphy Drive, Quinlin Court and Stetson Court. The District expects to select a contractor to complete this work later this month. The current estimated schedule is for all construction to be completed this summer, likely June – September to avoid impacts to plow operations during periods of inclement weather. There will be brief periods of service disruption, but we will work to minimize impacts and communicate to residents in a timely manner to give as much notice as possible. As a part of the waterline replacement, the remaining outdated meter pits and all service lines, which are in front yard landscape areas, will also be replaced. There will be impacts to the landscape areas of residential yards, we will make every effort to restore these areas to their original condition where possible.

Acceptable items: include tree limbs, loose pine needles, shrubs, brush with a maximum length of 6 feet and maximum diameter of 12 inches. Please note all loads must be covered upon arrival to the slash-mulch site. No dumping allowed Monday through Friday.

Unacceptable items include: appliances, compost, decorative wood chips, dirt, fencing, grass / hay, household trash / yard waste, leaves, lumber / pallets / railroad ties, pine cones, roots / stumps, weeds, yucca plants.



Too Many Bags? Friendly Reminder!

The HOA has been receiving calls about trash bags being left behind during pickup. This is due to Apex picking up the max amount of trash allowed per pickup and leaving the rest. We do understand that it is spring cleanup time, but the trash company will only allow up to 350 gallons of trash, or yard debris. This does include recycle on recycle day.

If you have more than the allotted 350 gallons of trash, we would recommend reaching out to Apex to schedule a bulk pickup prior to trash day, so that the extra bags will be taken care of.
