#### 2024 Slash/Mulch Site Now Open Saturdays ONLY April 6—October 26 8 a.m.—5 p.m.

Did you know that removing tree limbs, shrubs and brush from your property is essential for wildfire risk reduction? Good news — Douglas County provides a location to dispose of this unwanted slash. Douglas County's <u>slash-mulch site</u>, at **1400 Caprice Drive in Castle Rock**, opened April 6 and will remain open on Saturdays only from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. through October 26. This is the perfect place to dispose of limbs, shrubs and brush. The site also gives residents the opportunity to go home with fresh mulch. They have added a "green yard" waste drop off to accommodate grass/hay, leaves, pinecones, weeds and yucca plants.

Acceptable items include tree limbs, loose pine needles, shrubs, brush with a maximum length of 6 feet and maximum diameter of 12 inches. Please note all loads must be covered upon arrival to the slash-mulch site. \*\* Absolutely no dumping allowed Monday through Friday\*\*

<u>Unacceptable items include</u>: appliances, compost, decorative wood chips, dirt, fencing, household trash / lumber / pallets / railroad ties, roots / stumps.

During open season a County operated loader will be available to load free wood chips for homeowners to use as mulch. Material can be picked up anytime during the season the site is open to accept slash. In the event of inclement weather, please call 303.663.6274 to ensure that the site will be open as scheduled.

Please note the Slash-Mulch site in Douglas County is for Douglas County residents only.

#### System—CodeRED

ife can change in a moment - make sure you are connected to the CodeRED emergency notification system in Douglas County! The system, CodeRED, is a high-speed telephone emergency notification service allowing public safety agencies the ability to deliver pre-recorded information to targeted areas within the county.

Douglas County's public safety agencies encourage everyone to register their contact information in the CodeRED system (reverse 911). Registration is not automatic, but it may be critical to your safety and that of your family.

### DC Guidelines Regarding Dogs at Large

Animals must be kept under control for their own protection and to preserve the public's health and safety. Dogs found off the owner's or keeper's property are called "strays" and may be impounded. The owner or keeper may also be fined.

Dog owners are in violation of this law if they fail to properly control or allow a dog to run at large in the county. This ordinance does not apply in designated parks where dogs are permitted to run off leash.

Violations begin at \$50 per animal and increase in cost for the second and third violations, and the dog owner may receive a court summons.

If you happen upon an aggressive dog, report to DCAS at 303-660-7529 or 303-660-7500.

#### **Please Keep Noise From Disturbing Your Neighbors**

Please be considerate of your neighbors when playing music or creating noise of any kind. Douglas County does have a noise ordinance.

Some of the specific prohibitions include:

Radios, televisions, loudspeakers, musical instruments and similar amplified devices. The operating or playing of any radio, musical instrument or similar device which produces or reproduces sound on the public rights-of-way or across a residential or commercial property line in such a manner as to be plainly audible to any person other than the operator of the device. "Plainly audible" shall mean any sound emanating from the specific sound-producing sources mentioned here which can be heard from across a property line. For music and other noise emanating from the sound-producing sources mentioned here, words and phrases need not be discernable, bass reverberations are included.

Please be sure to trim back any over growth to allow for clear, unobstructed sight lines to ensure safety for passing motorists, cyclists, pedestrians and the like.

#### Fire Mitigation

#### Pinery HOA Sponsors Chipper Days Event

We have opened the sign up to chipper days on our website! This event provides curb-side chipping services to interested members of the community. This event has been helpful in the removal of slash and flammable debris that renders our community vulnerable to fire risks each year.

If you are pruning trees, raking needles, clearing pine cones from yards, this is all considered fire mitigation. The Pinery is recognized as a "FireWise" community through a certified program by NFPA (National Fire Prevention Association). We retain our certification for this program with the help of our residents. We have a minimum of 1800 hours that are required to be completed by the end of year, so logging your work helps to reach this goal. As an incentive, if we receive 25 logged entries, we hold a drawing for 3 \$25 gift card winners!

If you are unfamiliar with the logging process, you will go to Pinery.org, scroll down to find "Learn How" under the Fire Mitigation bubble. On the next page, find the link to log the hours and fill out the webform with the details about your mitigating.

To sign up for chipper days, the link will also be found on this page under the "Chipper Days" section.

## PHA Trash & Recycle Program Enrollment Form

The Pinery Homeowners' Association invites you to participate in the Trash and Recycle Program offered to Pinery residents.

Trash is picked up every Wednesday and recycling items are picked up every other Wednesday.

Each household may order two complementary carts 64 gallon and/or 96 gallon. There will be a \$25 delivery fee. (You may order below.)

All trash starts must be received in the PHA office no later than 1 p.m. on the Monday prior to the desired Wednesday service day. Trash carts will be delivered in 7—10 days.
