the responsibilities of the CSC.)


If you would like to serve your community in any of these ways, please consider having your name placed on the ballot.

Fall Leaf Collection Program

As the seasons change, so do your yardwork needs. You can now keep leaves out of the landfill by taking them to Douglas County's new Fall Leaf Collection site, open Saturdays in November from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. through Nov.15 at 1400 Caprice Drive in Castle Rock.

Only leaves will be accepted from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Nov. 1, Nov. 8, and Nov. 15.

Acceptable Items

Leaves only. Contamination of branches, bags, or green waste may get compostable loads rejected and sent to landfills.

In case of inclement weather, please call <u>303-548-7810</u> to ensure that the site will be open as scheduled.

Snow Removal in The Pinery

Douglas County Public Works is responsible for snow removal in the Pinery.

Roads are cleared of snow based on road priority. See below for more details.

Snow Removal Priorities:

Priority 1 - Arterial Roadways

These are major roadways with high traffic volumes and high operating speeds that provide critical transportation and emergency access and links within the County.

Priority 2 - Collector Roadways and School Bus Routes

When the snowfall has subsided and arterial roadways have been cleared, equipment is deployed to plow collector roadways and school bus routes. Collector roadways distribute traffic between arterial roadways and residential streets and often serve as links between subdivisions.

Priority 3 - Local Street and Cul-de-sacs

Local streets and cul-de-sacs provide for low and moderate traffic volumes within subdivisions and provide direct access to residences or private property. All local streets and cul-de-sacs are plowed during every storm unless accumulations are minor and are expected to melt the following day.

Here's what you can do:

- When shoveling, place snow on landscaped areas, not in the street.
- When snow is predicted, move your car from County streets to make room for plows.
- Drive safely near plows. Don't pass plows in operation and stay back.

New Trash Rates & Trash Cart Exchanges:

As we approach 2026, we mark five years with our current trash contractor, Apex Waste (formerly Little Dumpsters). The Pinery Board of Directors is pleased to announce that we have renewed our contract with Apex Waste for another term.

Over the past five years, despite rising inflation, the Board has successfully maintained stable pricing for trash services. We've worked diligently to keep costs unchanged, recognizing the importance of affordability for our community.

With the new contract, the Board has carefully reviewed projected costs and after thorough analysis, we've determined that a modest rate increase is necessary to continue providing reliable service. We've made every effort to keep this increase as reasonable as possible while ensuring long-term sustainability.

2026 trash service invoices for both yearly and quarterly customers will be mailed out on **November 1, 2025**.

Updated Pricing:

- Quarterly Customers:
 - Trash Service: \$81.00 (per quarter @ \$27.00 per month)
 - HOA Dues: \$8.25
 - Total Quarterly Cost: \$89.25
- Yearly Customers:
 - Trash Service: \$297.00 (per year @ \$24.75 per month)
 - HOA Dues: \$33.00
 - Total Yearly Cost: \$330.00

Trash Cart Exchanges

If you are currently using a Little Dumpsters trash cart, we will be transitioning those to the new Apex Trash Carts. This will be a large-scale project, and we want to make the process as smooth and convenient as possible for all homeowners.

To facilitate the exchange, we will be using our Large Item Pickup schedule. The PHA Office will email homeowners by street with specific instructions. Once you receive that email, please reply with the following information:

- Number of carts requested: 2 or 3 (Note: If you request more than 3 carts, there will be an additional charge of \$5.00 per cart per month.)
- Type of carts: For example, (2) Trash & (1) Recycle
- Size of carts: Choose between 64-gallon or 96-gallon options

If your current Little Dumpsters recycle cart and/or trash cart are working properly, **please do not** call the office to request an exchange at this time. We will be contacting you within the next few weeks to arrange for cart replacements

Douglas County Health Department Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Program

If you have paint from a recent project, old oil from your car's maintenance, or other hazardous waste from your recent DIY experience, Douglas County Health Department can help you safely dispose of it.

In place of a one-time annual event, the Douglas County Health Department is partnering with Waste Management to provide Douglas County residents with a low-cost service for household hazardous waste removal year-round. Acceptable Items:

- <u>Household Chemicals</u>: Ammonia, cleaning compounds, bleach, floor stripper, drain cleaner, rust remover, carpet/upholstery cleaner, tile/shower cleaner, and more
- <u>Automotive Products</u>: Antifreeze, motor oil, oil filters, fluids, polish, waxes, vehicle batteries, upholstery cleaners, and more
- <u>Consumer Electronics</u>: Computers, laptops, keyboards, monitors, microwaves, DVD/CD players, CD ROM, fax machines, cell phones, VCRs, desktop printers, scanners, gaming systems, related cords, and more
- <u>Paint Products</u>: Oil-based paint, latex paint, spray paint, artist paint, wood preservative, stain, caulk, sealer and more
- **Batteries**: Batteries of various sizes: AA, AAA, C, D and rechargeable.
- Garden Chemicals: Herbicide, insect spray/ insecticide, fertilizer, pesticide, and more
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs: Compact fluorescent lamps (CFL) and straight fluorescent tubes
- Thermometers and thermostats: Numerous items that contain mercury
- Flammable Items: Kerosene, gasoline, solvents and more
- Syringes and Lancets: Sharps, syringes, needles and lancets
- Swimming Pool Chemicals: Pool acid, stabilizer, chlorine

<u>Unacceptable items</u>: asbestos, ammunition and explosives, biological waste, medicines and prescriptions, commercial or business supplies, unknown or unlabeled materials, trash, including bulky items and furniture, incandescent light bulbs, appliances: washing machines, vacuums, tools, or refrigerators, tires, containers over 5 gallons, lamp fixtures, liquid mercury, leaking or empty containers, construction related materials, radioactive items, smoke detectors, items improperly packaged for transportation

The Pinery Storage Facility
Lease (Page 2, paragraph 5)
states that the Association
does not do removal of snow.
In addition to being very
costly, plowing snow at the
lots would be problematic.
The soft surfaces at the lot
could be easily damaged and
snow would, of necessity, be
plowed in front of spaces of
lessees.

Be sure to be aware of this as you make plans for use of your stored vehicle(s).

Christmas Tree Disposal

You can Recycle your tree December 26—January 31

Bring Christmas trees by at anytime and place in the mulching area. When recycling your tree, please be sure they are completely undecorated. This means removing all ornaments, lights, tinsel, garland, plastic wrap, tree stands, wire, rope, nails, etc. before bringing trees to be recycled. Live trees with artificial snow sprayed on the branches cannot be mulched.

Mulch available on-site while supplies last.

Apex Christmas Tree Pick Up

- For interested Pinery residents, live Christmas tree pick up by APEX Waste Solutions is designated for Wednesday, January 7th, 2026 (normal trash pick-up day of the week).
- Trees picked up by APEX will be taken as trash to a landfill and not recycled.
- Trees must be cut into 4-foot lengths and left in the general area where normal trash & recycling is picked up.
- You do not need to contact Apex ahead of time but you do need to have your tree at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. They will be coming EARLY for the trees. If they are not out and get missed there will be a go back charge.

ife can change in a moment - make sure you are connected to the CodeRED emergency notification system in Douglas County! The system, CodeRED, is a high-speed telephone emergency notification service allowing public safety agencies the ability to deliver pre-recorded information to targeted areas within the county.

Douglas County's public safety agencies encourage everyone to register their contact information in the CodeRED system (reverse 911). Registration is not automatic, but it may be critical to your safety and that of your family.
